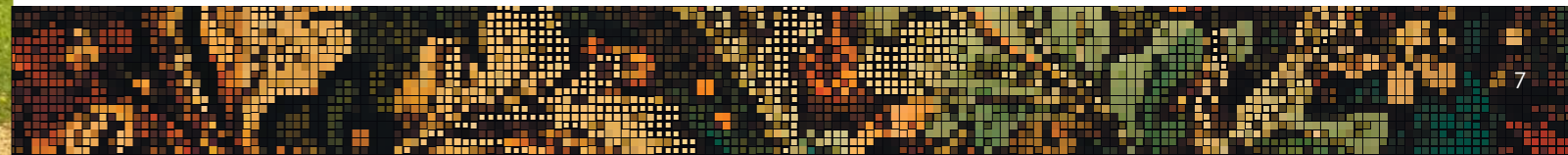
BATTLE - WHERE A LIFE WELL LIVED IS THERE FOR THE TAKING



MAKE THE MOST OF THE GREAT OUTDOORS

From cycling to sailing and from hiking to horse riding, Battle makes it easy to enjoy an outdoor life. Right on the doorstep is Battle Great Wood, laced with a network of trails, including a 3km circular walk and a 10km route for mountain biking. And, sitting in the glorious High Weald National Landscape, Tapestry is just a 15-minute drive from Hastings with its attractive coastline and country park.

You can also be at Rye Harbour Nature Reserve, Sissinghurst Castle Garden or Eastbourne beach in just over half an hour, and the Kent Downs or Brighton beach in around 75 minutes.





ENTERTAINMENT FOR ALL AGES

There's plenty to keep the whole family busy in Battle, Hastings and the surrounding area. Including pottery painting at Craft Time, delving into history at Battle Abbey, stepping into the art world at Hastings Contemporary and travelling back in time at Hastings Miniature Railway. And with so many other towns, villages and cities in easy reach, the options are endless.



LOTS OF PLACES TO MEET, EAT AND DRINK

Whether you prefer traditional pubs like The Bull Inn, cosy cafés like Baby Latte or smart restaurants like La Bella Napoli, Battle gives plenty of options for getting together. At Battle Deli & Coffee Shop you can call in for breakfast, lunch or afternoon tea and leave with pies, chutneys and more. Venues like Lucky's Café and The Kings Head are dog friendly as well as family friendly. And at Burton's Restaurant you can dine with an abbey view.



AN IDYLIC SETTING FOR FAMILY LIFE

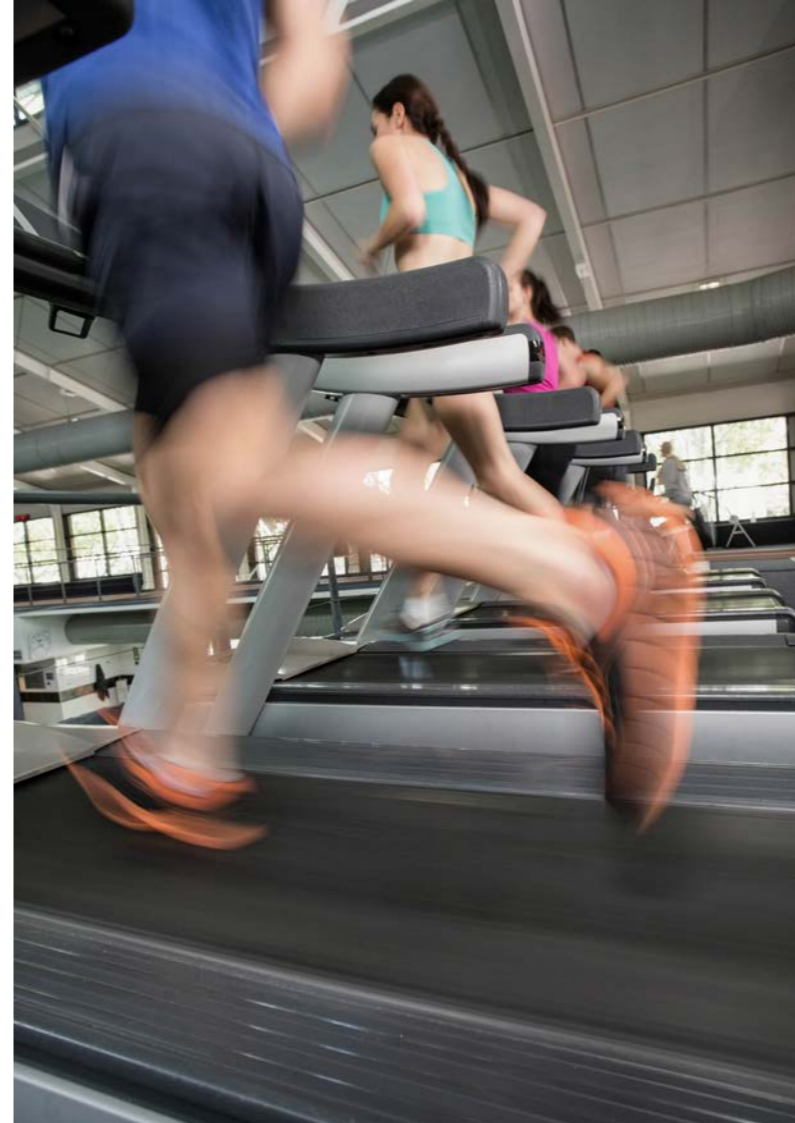
In Battle and the surrounding area, there's plenty keep to kids entertained – from building sandcastles to exploring dramatic landscapes and from visiting the aquarium to playing miniature golf. Essential amenities are also close by, including excellent schools, transport links and healthcare services.



SHOP LOCAL OR IN THE CITY

Battle's high street is populated with high quality independent stores such as Raggs clothing boutique, House of Cards gift shop and Barnaby's antiques and homeware store. Shops like Lifestyle and British Design, British Made offer everything from artisan candles to cookware. And Rother Books is a bibliophile's paradise.

For grocery top-up shops, there's a Tesco Express less than a 10-minute walk from Tapestry, and Tesco Extra and Sainsbury's are within a 10-minute drive. Hastings also offers a wider array of stores and well-known brands. And, for an even greater choice, you can be in Royal Tunbridge Wells in 23 minutes from Battle train station and at London Bridge in 1 hour 9 minutes.



STAY HEALTHY AND HAPPY

Whether you're into high-impact sports or gentler pursuits, there are lots of options for staying fit and well in Battle. An 11-minute cycle away is Battle Sports Centre with a sports hall, gym, dance studio, pitches, and an array of clubs and classes. There's also a BMX track and skatepark in town, and clubs for martial arts, cricket and more.

Crowhurst Park Leisure Club is just a 5-minute drive from Tapestry and has a beautiful pool as well as classes ranging from yoga to salsa to aquafit. And Sedlescombe Golf Club, a 10-minute drive away, has floodlit padel courts as well as a beautiful course.

A GREAT EDUCATION

Battle & Langton C of E Primary School is only around a mile from Tapestry. Claverham Community College for secondary school pupils is around a 7-minute drive away. And children with special education needs are well catered for at ISP School, an 8-minute walk away. All three schools have a good Ofsted rating, and the independent Battle Abbey School, which takes children from three months to 18 years, has an outstanding Ofsted rating.



THE RIGHT CONNECTIONS

With convenient travel links, Tapestry is well placed for making the most of everything this corner of the country has to offer. And it's easy to get out of town, and even the country, whenever you like.

Tapestry is just 2.5 miles from the A21, which sweeps down to Hastings and the south coast and up to London. And it's only a 10-minute walk from Battle train station. There are bus stops a few minutes' walk away with regular services into town and out to nearby towns and villages. And, for foreign trips, you can be at London Gatwick airport or Dover Ferry Port in less than an hour and a half.



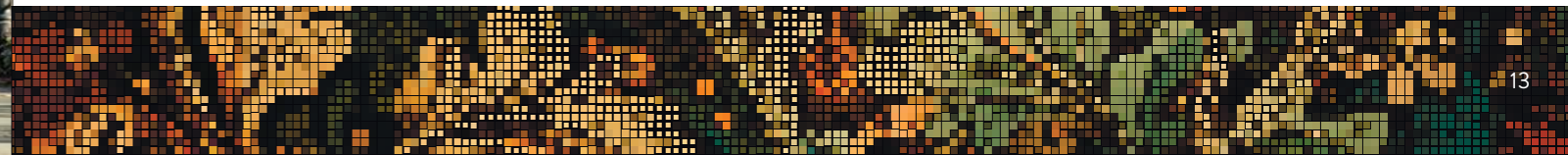
BY CAR FROM TAPESTRY

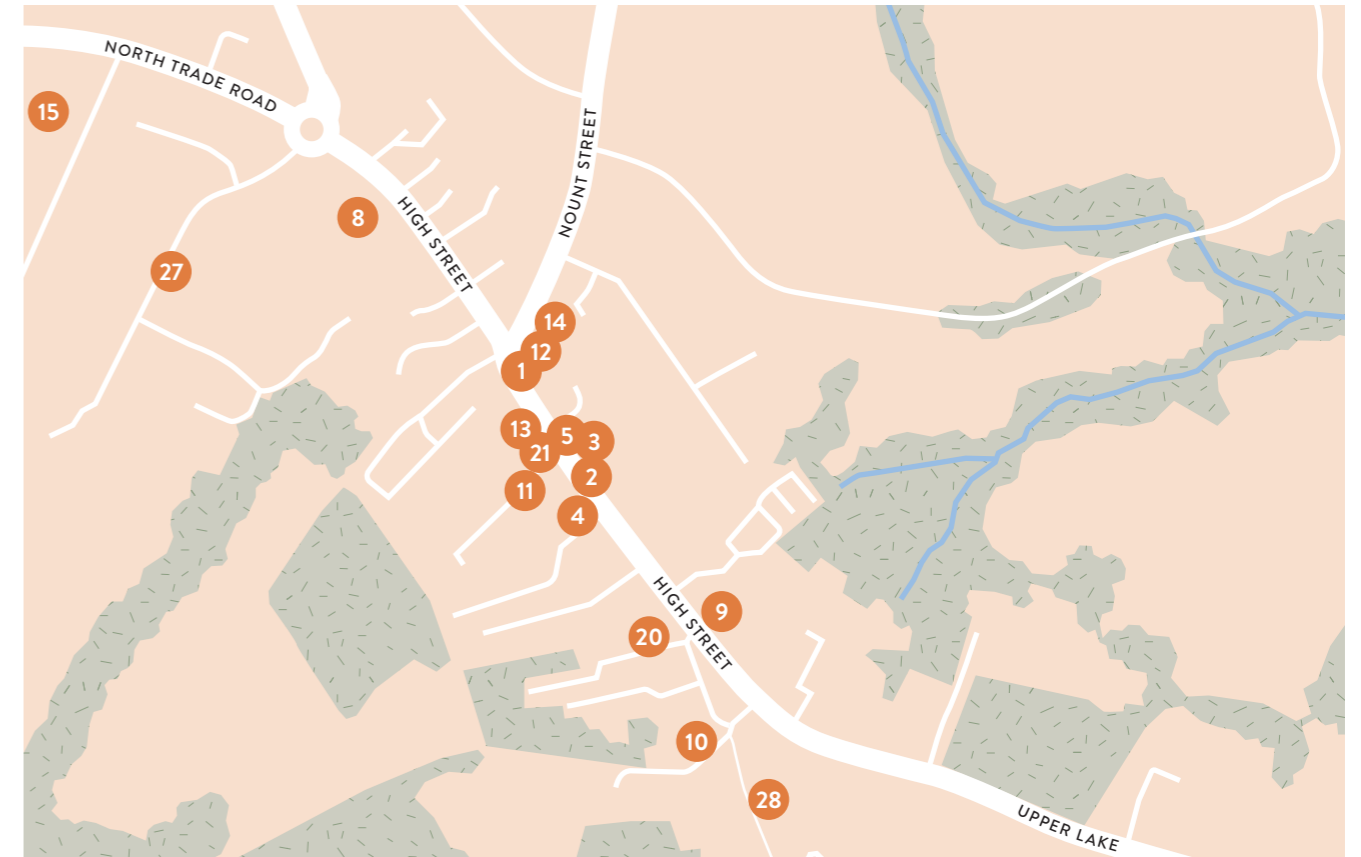
